This grant is suitable for students from non-European universities who wish to spend a semester or two at University of Applied Sciences (FH) Upper Austria.

Target group: Undergraduates, graduates

Duration: 4 to 10 months

Age limit: 35 years

Monthly rate: 1,300€

Application period for Ernst Mach: open from October to 1st February (for academic year 2026/2027)

Deadline for application to FH Upper Austria: open until 5th January 2026 (to receive your acceptance letter)

 - CV (resume)
 - Motivation letter
 - Learning Agreement
 - Transcripts of Records
- 4 Finish and submit your application form for Ernst Mach grant until 1st February.
- 5 Awarded students will be announced in mid-July before the new academic year
